## "Hands-Free" cell phones no safer

Experts revealed whether it's hands-free or hand-held you are 4 times more likely to crash. This according to a report released by the AAA's Foundation for Traffic Safety.

Since July 1, California drivers are banned from using hand-held phones. Over 40,000 tickets were generated.

It's the dialing that distracts. Most crashes take place with driver distraction in less than 3 seconds. Drivers who call are distracted at least one half a second. That's about 1/6 of the time to avoid an accident.

## Monster Verdict by DC : excellent case management- - Dr. Craig Johnson

Larry L'Heureaux, a 61 year old mortgage broker was stopped in traffic when his Chevy Blazer was rear-ended by Enterprise Rent-A-Car shuttle bus.

Enterprise admitted liability but vigorously disputed causation and injuries.

Dr. Johnson saw Larry 3 days post accident. After a month Johnson referred his patient to an orthopedic surgeon for what became a two level fusion from C4 to C5.

The jury awarded \$900,000<u>. L'Heareaux</u> <u>vs. Enterprise</u> San Diego Superior Court Oct 24, 2008.
